**NOTICE OF ANNOUNCEMENT OF REQUEST FOR NOMINATIONS
FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE MARIN COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION
COMMISSION (LAFCo) AND REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST**

The Marin County City Selection Committee is seeking letters of interest from elected officials from Marin's 11 cities and towns interested in being considered for appointment as Alternate City Member on the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo). The current incumbent is not seeking re-election and must resign from the LAFCo Board upon expiration of his Councilmember term. The available seat has a four-year term expiring in May 2020 and the successful appointee would serve as Alternate to the two City Members on the Commission for the remainder of the current term, through May 2020.

Pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, the composition of the Local Agency Formation Commissions (LAFCos) shall generally include seven regular members that includes county (two), city (two), special district (two), and public (one) representation. Each represented category also has an alternate.

The next City Selection Committee will convene at 6:00p.m. on Wednesday, October 23, 2019 in the Novato Council Chambers, 901 Sherman Avenue, Novato, CA 94945 to review letters of interest received and make an appointment to serve the remainder of the term as Alternate City Representative to Marin LAFCo.
