NOTICE OF ANNOUNCEMENT OF REQUEST FOR NOMINATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE MARIN COUNTY LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION (LAFCo) AND REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST

The Marin County City Selection Committee is seeking letters of interest from elected officials from Marin's 11 cities and towns interested in being considered for appointment to serve the remainder of the unexpired terms of one of the two City Members on the Marin County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo), as well as one Alternate seat. One City Representative seat with term expiring May, 2024, and one Alternate Representative seat with term expiring May 2024. Appointments would be to serve the remaining 18 months of the unexpired terms of each of the two available seats.

Pursuant to the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, the composition of the Local Agency Formation Commissions (LAFCOs) shall generally include seven regular members that includes county (two), city (two), special district (two), and public (one) representation. Each represented category also has an alternate.

The next City Selection Committee will convene at 5:30pm on Wednesday, October 26, 2022. The Committee will review letters of interest received and consider appointment to serve the remaining 18 months of the unexpired terms of each of the two available seats: City Representative and Alternate City Representative to Marin LAFCo, with both terms expiring May, 2024.
