The Marin County Council of Mayors and Councilmembers (MCCMC) is pleased to support your bill, ACA 1, which gives voters the opportunity to lower the voter threshold requirements for special taxes by a local government for the purpose of providing funding for affordable housing and public infrastructure projects from 2/3rds approval to 55% approval. Local governments have widespread and urgent infrastructure needs and the high cost of housing in the state is well-documented.
