NOTICE OF ANNOUNCEMENT OF REQUEST FOR NOMINATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION AND REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST

The Marin County City Selection Committee is seeking letters of interest from those interested in being considered for appointment to represent the County of Marin on the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) to serve a 4-year term beginning February 10, 2023. MTC Commission members may be elected or appointed officials, or members of the general public. Pursuant to Government Code Section 66504: "Commissioners shall be selected for their special familiarity with the problems and issues in the field of transportation."

The Marin County Council of Mayors and Councilmembers City Selection Committee has been asked to furnish the Marin County Board of Supervisors with the names of up to three (3) nominees from which the Board shall appoint a representative to represent Marin County and serve a four-year term that will commence on February 10, 2023. The incumbent is outgoing Marin County Supervisor and Assemblymember-Elect Damon Connolly.

The next City Selection Committee will convene at 5:30p.m. on Wednesday, January 25, 2023 via Zoom webinar (link to be provided on the agenda packet that will be published no later than Friday, January 20, 2023, to review letters of interest received and recommend nominees for submission to the Marin County Board of Supervisors for consideration and possible appointment. One appointment will be made to represent the County of Marin.
